## American Council On Renewable Energy CEO McGinn to Address Summit Conference

**Colorado Springs, Colo. – Jan. 31, 2013** – Vice Admiral Dennis V. McGinn (USN, ret.), President and CEO, American Council On Renewable Energy (ACORE), will address the Fifth Annual Global New Energy And Manufacturing Summit.

In 2011, Retired Vice Admiral Dennis V. McGinn took the helm as President and CEO of ACORE where he advances the organization's mission of building a secure and prosperous America with clean, renewable energy. Under McGinn's leadership, ACORE launched EnergyFactCheck, a website designed to rebalance the debate about renewable energy, providing fact-based information to counter misinformation about the industry.

He serves as co-chairman of the CNA Military Advisory Board advising policy makers on the nexus of energy and national security, and also serves as an international security senior fellow at the Rocky Mountain Institute. He is on the Steering Committee of the Energy Future Coalition, a member of the United States Energy Security Council, and a member of the Bipartisan Policy Center Energy Board. He was previously with Battelle Memorial Institute, where he was a corporate officer and led the energy, transportation, and environment division.
